Christopher Clady made the motion to approve Resolution 6-2024 Resolution declaring the cancellation and Rescission of Resolution 5-2024 regarding the necessity to levy a tax exceeding the ten-mill limitation and requesting the certification of the County Auditor (O.Const.Art.XII 2; R.C. 5705.03, .19, .191, .25) and declaring an emergency and William Herman Jr. second. Motion Approved with 6 ayes.

Larry Sprang made the motion to approve Resolution 7-2024 Resolution declaring the necessity to levy a tax exceeding the ten-mill limitation and requesting the certification of the County Auditor (O.Const.Art.XII 2; R.C. 5705.03,.19,.191,.25) and declaring an emergency and David Artrip Jr. second. Motion Approved with 6 ayes.

The Council had a discussion on the disposal of the guns owned by the Village of Perrysville. Council recommended getting an appraisal on the guns then they will decide on what to do with them at the next Council meeting.

Herman made the motion to approve having the two alleys paved by McB Paving at a total cost of \$8,777.00 and Sprang second. Motion Approved with 6 ayes.

The Mayor reported he talked with Mr. Ramey about the high grass and Mr. Ramey informed him he will be getting it mowed.

The Mayor also informed the Council he was approached by Mr. Stull about the letter he received on his building and Mr. Stull would like more time to make improvements and the Village Administrator said it was in Ashland County hands because that is where the letter came from that Mr. Stull received.
